

The History of the Cabins in Hope

On April 14, 1931 Claude & Rose Polmateer purchased almost 4 acres of gorgeous river front property in Hope, NY and began renovations on an old “camp” that was to become their home. More importantly, they constructed 4 roadside cabins and in the summer of 1932 they opened for business as Polmateer Cabins.



After Claude passed away in 1962, Rose continued the business for more than 25 years. Rose passed away in the spring of 1990 at the age of 85, having run her business for 57 seasons.

Now, in 2009, 77 years after the first travelers rested at the Polmateers' and 20 years following Rose's sunset season, **The Cabins in Hope...An Adirondack Bed and Breakfast** welcomes new travelers. We are privileged to continue over a half century of tradition by providing sincere hospitality and visual refreshment. We are combining the best of 20th century Adirondack vacation ambience with 21st century amenities to make your stay a memorable one.

Take Route 87, the Northway, until exit #15: Saratoga Springs. Head west on Rts 9/50. Turn left/south onto Broadway in downtown Saratoga Springs. In a couple of blocks, look for the Route 29 West sign and turn right.

Follow Route 29 West for 23.2 miles

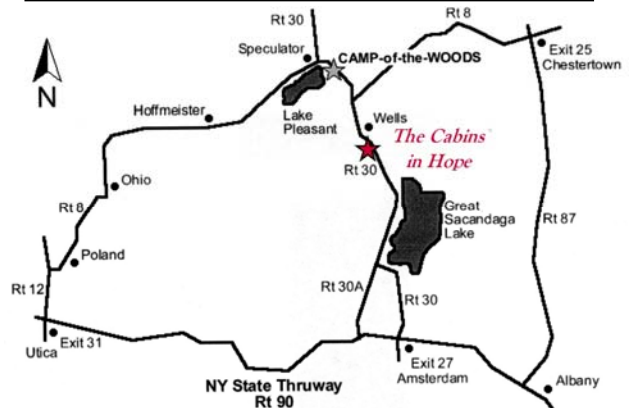
At the intersection of NY 30 (Dunkin' Donuts on the NW corner), turn right on NY 30. In .3 miles turn left to stay on NY 30. After 4.6 miles turn right to stay on NY 30.

We are approximately 19 miles from there, straight north.

Your next landmark will be the “welcome to Northville” sign. When you see the bridge on your right, you will be 9.3 miles from the Cabins.

When you see the Hope fire station, you will be 2.2 miles from our sign. Take a left down the drive to the Main house.

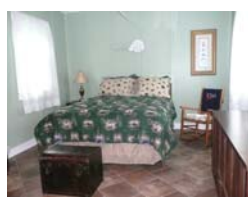

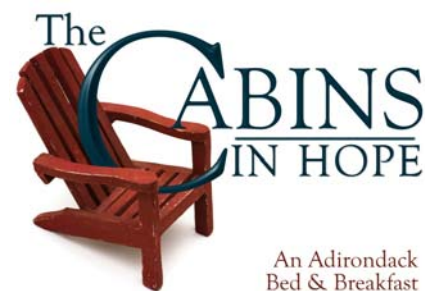
